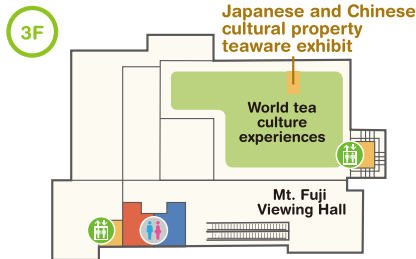


Venue Tea Museum, Shizuoka

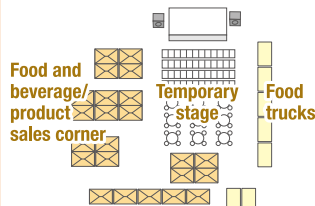

See, drink, and enjoy teas from China, Taiwan, and South Korea! Tea-related utensils, etc., from other countries will also be on display.

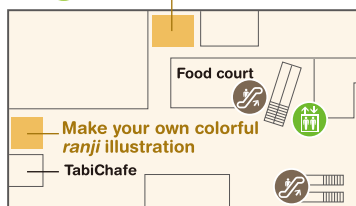


Color-in your own colorful ranji illustration

Hands-on tea farm experience facility

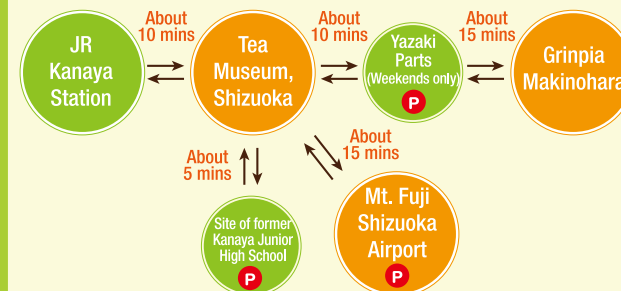
Fee applies
